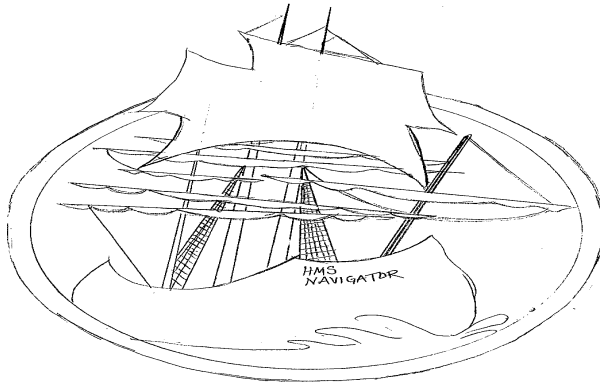

They will also be able to demonstrate that they have been an asset to their school or greater community through participation in clubs, sport or any other extracurricular activities.

- Criteria:
- \*\*\* Graduating senior from Hamden High School, New Haven Magnet Schools or local technical high schools
  - \*\*\* Completion of the entire scholarship form
  - \*\*\* Essay of 500-1000 words (not more than one page double spaced) on: How have you embodied the fundamentals, spirit and/ or lessons of the Navigator Program as a foundation for your high school experience?
  - \*\*\* Proof of Admission to an institution of higher learning
  - \*\*\* Copy of official high school transcripts
  - \*\*\* Name and contact information for proof
